



Strategic Advisor in Indigenous Education (Permanent Full-Time)

The Saskatchewan School Boards Association (SSBA) is seeking a permanent full-time Strategic Advisor in Indigenous Education. This position is responsible for supporting Boards of Education and school division administration in engaging Indigenous peoples and strengthening student achievement within the K-12 education sector. This position guides and recommends direction for the Indigenous Council in acquiring on-going support from member boards for Reconciliation and prioritizing Indigenous education throughout boards of education strategic plans. Responsibilities also include identifying, promoting and advising boards of education and school division administration with promising practices that support student achievement and engagement. This position reports to the Director, Board Development, Strategic HR, Legal and FNME Services.

Typically the knowledge, skills and abilities required for this position are obtained through successful completion of an undergraduate degree in Education, Human Resources, Social Sciences, Law or Administration or a related field. Experience, extensive knowledge and understanding of Indigenous communities and their respective culture and their current issues is essential to this position. Fluency in an Indigenous Language based in Saskatchewan is an asset.

The SSBA offers a competitive salary with health benefits, pension, and professional development opportunities. The salary range is \$83,538 to \$133,569.

The SSBA is committed to workplace diversity and encourages a culture of teamwork and flexibility. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply, however applicants of Indigenous ancestry will be given priority.
